The Center for Advanced Studies in Agriculture and Food Security (CAS-AFS), University of Agriculture, Faisalabad is offering MS and Ph.D. fellowships under the Project titled "Establishment of National Center for Genome Editing for Crop Improvement and Human health (NCGE)". Specified research areas are: **For MS:** (1) Development of biotic and abiotic stress tolerant solanaceous vegetables through "omics" and genome editing technologies. (2) Genome editing in wheat for yield improvement through CRISPR/Cas9 system. (3) Development of early maturing date palm lines via CRISPR/Cas9 system. (4) Development of CRISPR/Cas based diagnosis of typhoid, TB and cancer genetic markers.
