

NOTIFICATION

No.SR-I/19(iii)/26-27/ 1920 . As per approved schedule for admission to undergraduate degree programs the test/interview of the candidates claiming 20 marks being '**Hafiz-e-Quran**' for seeking admission to 1st degree programs (except B.Ed.) during the Academic Session, 2026-2027 at Main Campus and UAF Constituent Colleges, will be conducted on 12.08.2026 at 08.00 a.m. in the Office of the Director Students' Affairs, prior to display of 1st merit list. Those who could not appear on 12.08.2026 will be interviewed/tested as left-over candidates on 13.08.2026. Accordingly, the following Committee alongwith its SOP/TORs to conduct test/interview of the candidates has been approved by the Vice Chancellor: -

TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- the test/interview of Hafiz-e-Quran for admission to undergraduate degree programs will be held on Wednesday the 12th August, 2026 at 8.00 a.m. in the Office of the Director Students' Affairs. The left-over candidates, if any, will be interviewed on Thursday the 13th August, 2026.
- the list of candidates who qualify the test will be communicated under confidential cover to all the concerned admission authorities by the Directorate of Students' Affairs duly signed by the Convener/ Members of the Committee under intimation to this office.
- while preparing merit list, the admission authorities would carefully check that 20 additional marks be only added for a candidate who have qualified/passed the test as per list received from the Directorate of Students' Affairs.
- no additional marks will be added to the merit of a candidate who fails to appear in the test. The merit of such candidates will, however, be determined according to marks obtained in the last examination (without 20 marks).
- inspite of all above efforts, if it is found during scrutiny that 20 marks have been added in the merit to a candidate without appearing/ qualifying test, the concerned admission authority will be held responsible.

The Vice Chancellor has authorized the Principals of UAF Constituent Colleges to constitute such Committees at their respective Campus under intimation to this office for the candidates applying for admission to the concerned Campus. It may be ensured that 20 marks be added in the merit for the candidates under fool proof and transparent system. The above terms of reference and procedure shall remain the same for these Committees.

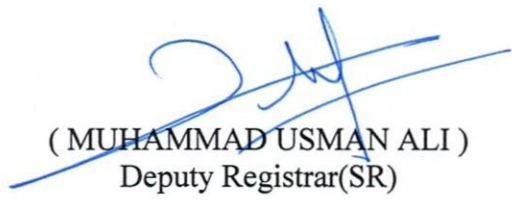
