



Crop Monitoring App

Kisan360 is an innovative platform which utilizes satellite imagery to provide comprehensive crop monitoring services and offers a range of supportive interventions. Kisan360 enhances the research and development efforts of researchers, faculty, extension workers, and students while enabling farmers to remotely track crop health, moisture levels, and variable-rate fertilizer applications, along with a seven-day weather forecast.

Balanced fertilizer-use App

UAF had devised a soil test based fertilizer prediction models to predict the required amount of N and P for desired yield of major crops, giving the suggestion to the farmers about the recommended fertilizer usage in their field.



Co-curricular Activities and Honours

- The Senior Tutor Office of UAF oversees extracurricular activities through the Art and Literary Forum (ALF) and the Tutorial Group System (TGS). The ALF includes 19 clubs, societies, and forums, while the TGS comprises 268 tutorial groups. Together, these initiatives engage over 25,000 students in developing their soft skills and other competencies.
- In 2023, UAF students affiliated with the Art and Literary Forum (ALF) earned 110 medals and trophies in various All Pakistan Level Inter-Institutional Art and Literary Competitions. Additionally, this office organized over 80 events, including the Lyallpur Arts and Literature Festival, Gur Mela, Kapaas Mela, Wahdian Mela, as well as literary competitions, workshops, seminars, and motivational lectures.




